**25/082 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION SESSION**

Following a request from a resident, the Chair gave a summing up of the situation so far regarding planning application 24/04834/FUL and the latest updates from Severn Trent. There was then some discussion around questions and objections that residents had in relation to that application. The points made have been covered in APC's response to SC Planning (see separate document).

**25/083 PLANNING**

a) Council considered the following **planning applications**:

**24/04834/FUL Land adjacent to Wedgefields/Shrewsbury Road**

Proposal: Construction of 44 dwellings – amended application.

After discussion, the Parish Council resolved to object to the amended application (Prop: AM, Sec: SD, unanimous). The submitted response is attached in full as a separate document.

**25/03301/VAR Sunnyside Farm, Hadnall SY4 4BJ**

Proposal: Variation of Conditions 2, 12, 13 and 14 attached to permission 22/03734/FUL dated 22 November 2022.

Cllr Downing pointed out that the amended application refers to a covering letter, which has not been published. The Parish Council decided to defer its response until the detail is available but could see nothing in the amendments so far to cause concern. Planning Committee to decide response by email.

b) There were no further **planning applications** received in advance of this meeting.

**25/084            RoSPA INSPECTION**

After discussion, it was resolved to proceed with an Urgent Inspection of the children's play area, to be carried out by RoSPA PlaySafety at a cost of £420 + VAT and then to sign up for a scheduled annual inspection from 2026 (June/July each year) at around £90 + VAT per year. (Prop: SD, Sec: LT, For: LT, SD, HC. Against: AM, carried by majority)
